Today we are launching a series of new RSVP management functions for Level 3+ councils. Watch this space for detailed instructions soon, after we iron out a few issues. Please report any other unusual behavior to webmaster@naepc.org. The new features will include:

- 1. The admin being able to manually create an RSVP for a member, including payment information.
- 2. The admin being able to edit some aspects of an RSVP.
- 3. Restructuring of the Events admin pages so that the RSVPs reside on a tab off of each event detail page.
- 4. The admin being able to indicate show/no-show for each member for each event. That is handy for CE credit accounting.
